

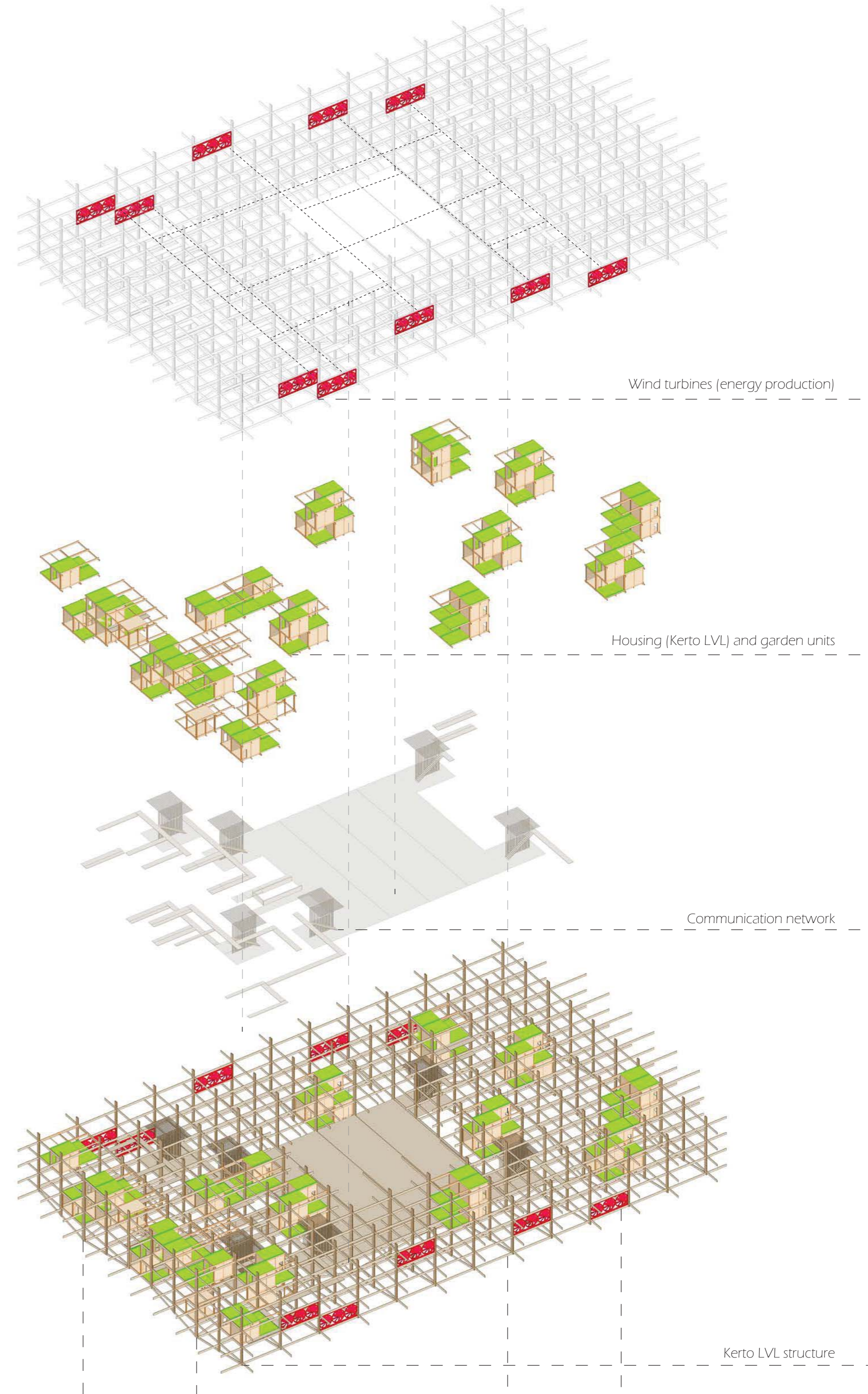
Warsaw is in a promising new cycle of re-urbanisation that needs density if it is to be optimized (Clark, 2015)

There is a real need to change. Warsaw needs to be transformed into a city for people, without this having to be accomplished by dividing social life and, so far, restricting the dominating car traffic. In fact, both should be combined to accommodate the actual needs of **Modern Nomads society**, where people are **constantly on move**, in

order to serve it best. Accordingly, the stop of urban sprawl can be achieved by investing in smart housing projects within the centre of Warsaw, creating **multi-functional** spaces. Thus, one of the best locations for a **kick-start** is Warsaw Central Railway Station, located in the heart of the city.

The Modern Nomads housing project is intended for people who **commute daily** to outlying locations, but the project can also serve **homeless** as a rehabilitation program.
